

## Material List

**Course:** Studio Painting 2 and 3

**Instructor:** Brian Burnett

Note: Students should be prepared to begin painting in the first class.

### Oil Colour List:

Colours	tube size
Titanium White	150 ml.
Zinc white (optional)-excellent for glazing with white	“
Yellow Ochre	60 ml.
Burnt Sienna	“
Burnt Umber	“
Ultramarine Blue	“
Phthalo Blue	“
Phthalo Green or Viridian	“
Sap Green	“
Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Crimson	“
Azo Red light. or Cadmium Red light	“
Cadmium Yellow Light or Hansa Yellow	“
Cadmium Yellow Deep	“
Dioxazine Violet or Winsor Violet	“

Note: Colour names may vary with manufactures.

**For foundation stains etc.** I recommend that oil painters use acrylics as setup colour(s), one or two favourite colours, to enable quick foundation drying. Then proceed with oils on top.

### Oil Mediums

Non-toxic oil alternatives are Walnut Oil and Walnut Alkyd Medium 118 ml  
(no other mediums or cleaners are necessary) available at Curry's Art Store.  
Alternate “cleaner” for oil is a 50/50 mix of Sunlight dish soap and vegetable oil

### More Toxic Mediums (but accepted)

Odorless Mineral Spirits or Gamsol 940 ml  
Alkyd medium (Gamblin's or Tri Art) or linseed (very slow drying) 75 ml

Alkyd Gel (Fast Drying). either DV.P.or Gamblin 150 ml  
An alternative to Alkyd Gel is Gamblin's Cold Wax – has a matte finish

**Do Not Buy:** Liquin, Talatine, Copal Painting Medium, Grumtine, Turpentine, Varsol, Cobalt Driers, Stevenson's Alkyd medium.

My strongest recommendation is to use M. Graham or Gamblin mediums for oil painting. You can get extensive information at [www.gamblincolors.com](http://www.gamblincolors.com). Curry's and Above Ground carry Gamblin products. Curry's sells M. Graham products.

**Water Based Oils:** There currently are three brands of water-based oils on the market  
Holbien Duo Aqua Oils, Grumbacher Max, Winsor & Newton  
Artisan Water Mixabl Oils

**Recommended Brands:** Gamblin, M.Graham, Williamsburg, Kama, Old Holland Winsor & Newton (**Winton** made by Winsor & Newton is not recommended)
