

Materials list - 812 Life Drawing 2: Drawing Better Bodies

Required Materials*

- a pad of newsprint – 18 x 24 inches is adequate, but if you like to work more expansively, 24 x 36” may suit you better
- Optional - a pad of 18 x 24 cartridge paper for longer drawings, 24 x 36” pads can be found as well.
- A couple of sticks of willow or vine charcoal – ¼” diameter, medium or soft grade
- one stick of “B” or “HB” conté crayon (“Conte à Paris” brand preferable to “Galley” or others)
- One package of earth-tone drawing sticks (red, orange, brown) Gallery brand is fine)
- one charcoal pencil – General’s Medium
- one HB or H graphite pencil
- One soft - 3B or 4B graphite pencil - Progresso woodless graphite pencils are a good option
- large size kneadable eraser
- white vinyl eraser
- bulldog or fold-back clips- at least two
- x-acto knife or snap-type knife

*for the first class, be sure to bring a pad of newsprint, a conte crayon (black or brown) and some compressed charcoal. The rest of the materials list can be discussed at that time, if there are any materials you are unsure about.
