

# MATERIAL LIST: <br> Perspective Drawing with Roberta McNaughton 

Please keep all purchase receipts in case items need to be returned.

Note:
If you have coloured pencils, a pad of large drawing paper ( $18^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ or larger), drawing pencils beyond just HB, or any of the above list at home then use them. This is just a guided list and all prices are approximate.

- T-square - clear acrylic - $30^{\prime \prime}$ or something like it (\$30)
- Set square (triangle ruler - 8 to $10 \prime$ - 90/45 degree or 30/60 degrees - either one) (\$5)
- $2 x$ Cartridge paper pad $-18^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ or larger.
- Any large white drawing pad ( $\$ 5 \times 2=\$ 10$ )
- Pencils: $2 \mathrm{H}, \mathrm{H}, \mathrm{HB}, 2 \mathrm{~B}, 8 \mathrm{~B}$ - any brand of pencil (\$5-\$1 each)
- Pencil sharpener (\$4)
- Pink or white eraser (\$2)
- Masking tape (\$2)
- Pencil crayons: 5 different colours for drawing of different coloured vanishing point lines to lessen the confusion of multiple lines (\$10-\$2 each)
- Roll of tracing paper - 18" (\$13)


## Optional:

- Circles template or compass to draw circles up to $3^{\prime \prime}(\$ 13)$.
(We won't use this more than 2 times and you can draw your own circles if you decide to not buy this tool.)
