



MATERIAL LIST: Perspective Drawing with Roberta McNaughton

Please keep all purchase receipts in case items need to be returned.

Note:

If you have coloured pencils, a pad of large drawing paper (18" x 24" or larger), drawing pencils beyond just HB, or any of the above list at home then use them. This is just a guided list and all prices are approximate.

- T-square - clear acrylic – 30" or something like it (\$30)
- Set square (triangle ruler – 8 to 10" – 90/45 degree or 30/60 degrees – either one) (\$5)
- 2x Cartridge paper pad – 18" x 24" or larger.
- Any large white drawing pad (\$5 x 2 = \$10)
- Pencils: 2H, H, HB, 2B, 8B – any brand of pencil (\$5 - \$1 each)
- Pencil sharpener (\$4)
- Pink or white eraser (\$2)
- Masking tape (\$2)
- Pencil crayons: 5 different colours for drawing of different coloured vanishing point lines to lessen the confusion of multiple lines (\$10 - \$2 each)
- Roll of tracing paper – 18" (\$13)

Optional:

- Circles template or compass to draw circles up to 3" (\$13).
(We won't use this more than 2 times and you can draw your own circles if you decide to not buy this tool.)
